



Heidi Sunday Designs

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EASIEST BABY BOOTIE

Use any needle size appropriate to yarn size (i.e.: worsted: 8; sport/dk: 6; fingering: 4)

Size of yarn determines bootie size:

Worsted = Full Term, Sport Weight = Sm Newborn, Fingering Weight = Premie

Cast on 26 stitches, leaving a tail approx 10 inches

Row 1-2 Knit across

Row 3 K 2, YO, K2 tog, K19 to last 3 stitches, YO, K2 tog, K1 (eyelets made)

Row 4 Knit

Repeat rows 3 and 4 until there are 5 eyelets on each side

Row 12 Knit

Row 13 Bind off 5, Knit 21

Row 14 Bind off 5, Knit 16

Row 15-19 Knit 16

Row 20 K2 tog, K15

Row 21 K2 tog, K14

Row 22 K2 tog, K13

Row 23 K2 tog, K12

Row 24 K2 tog, K11

Row 25 K2 tog, K10

Row 26 K10

Cut yarn approx 10" long, thread a needle, and pass it through the remaining stitches (starting from opposite end like a drawstring), drawing them tightly into a circle. Tie and knot, then stitch up the front of the toe of the bootie. Use cast on yarn tail to sew up the back end of the bootie. Make a tie (use ribbon or crochet or braid a chain), and weave through the eyelets.
