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EVERYBODY'S PONCHO

The poncho is knitted as 2 rectangles which are sewn together in the front & back. Cast on the number shown in the below chart for the size & gauge, then Knit 3 rows.

14" Tall Doll	9"	4 ½" x 9"	2 strands DK #10	3.25	15	120/60 yds
2 yr	17.5"	9" x 18"	2 strands worsted #13 (use only 1 strand if chunky yarn is used)	2.5	23	290/145
3 yr	22.5"	10" x 20"	"	2.5	25	360/180
4 yr	28.5"	11" x 22"	"	2.5	27	440/220
8 yr	30"	12" x 24"	"	2.5	29	520/260
Teen	33"	13" x 26"	"	2.5	31	600/300
Sm Adult	36"	14" x 28"	"	2.5	35	700/350
Adult	38"	15" x 30"	"	2.5	37	800/400
Lg Adult	40"	16" x 32"	"	2.5	41	920/460

Row 4: K 1, (YO, P2tog) across to end of row

Row 5-9: K all rows (or seed stitch: K1, P1 across every row & do the opposite of each stitch on the reverse side)

Repeat rows 4 – 9 until piece is 1" less than desired width, then knit all rows for 1", then bind off loosely

Sew pieces together on front and back as shown in diagram below. For a rolled neckline finish, use a 16" circular needle in a size (or two!) smaller than the one the poncho was knitted with, pick up stitches around the neck and knit 2 or 3 inches if desired. Add fringe, tassels or a braided/twisted/I-cord tie to decorate. You can also simply knit every row, but it takes more yarn and makes a heavier fabric.
